

Adopted 02-28-2020, published August 2019.

The green lines represent the approximate boat path when pulling a skier through the course or other activities outside of the course. The outer yellow line is approximately 50 feet outside the center of the course.

The magenta colored line represents an offset of 75 feet from the boat line considered a safe distance considering a normal line length.

Boat traffic should try to adhere to the green lines or area inside the green lines.

As a point of reference the turn bouys are 35 feet from the center of the course so boat traffic should try to stay within about two boat widths of the outside of the turn bouys.

There is considerable room along the berm side of the lake for activites such as barefoot skiing that operate in the a straight line (as shown by the magenta dashed line).

Boat and skier traffic should stay on the south side of the two anchor buoys in the mouth of the quiet area of the lake.

The map also identifies area of potential restricted dock placement for lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 27 and 28.
